2. Improve SSE maintenance including bench replacement, erosion control, and signage
3. Prioritize smaller place-making improvements including plantings, art and creative elements
4. Prioritize SSE in economic and racially diverse Rainier Beach and South Park/Georgetown
5. Support neighborhood groups working to open their local shoreline street ends (Eddy)
6. Recruit additional members, volunteers and stewards
7. Assist SDOT in new ordinance, Parks Contract, and Budget
